

## **ANNOUNCEMENT OF A CALL FOR 2017 APPLICATIONS: HONS/M/PhD BURSARIES OR POST DOCTORAL FELLOWSHIPS**

The DST-NRF CoE-MaSS Bursary and Post Doctoral Fellowships funding instrument is a competitive platform providing support for Postgraduate Students and Post Doctoral Fellows working specifically within the CoE-MaSS' research theme areas:

*Symmetry Analysis; Logic and Computation; Mathematics in Industry; Mathematical Physics; Statistical Theory and Applied Statistics; Stochastic, Linear Processes and Number Theory; Operator Algebras and Functional Analysis; Modelling and Analysis in Life Sciences; Algebra and Topology; and Mathematics Education Research.*

Applicants must be a **full-time** registered Postgraduate Student or appointed Post Doctoral Fellow at a CoE-MaSS Node University in 2017:

*Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University (NMMU); North-West University (NWU); Stellenbosch University (SU); University of Cape Town (UCT); University of Johannesburg (UJ); University of Kwa-Zulu Natal (UKZN); University of Limpopo (UL); University of Pretoria (UP); University of South Africa (UNISA); University of Venda (UniVen); University of the Western Cape (UWC); or University of the Witwatersrand (Wits).*

This Call is open to consider eligible applicants for (i) **full bursaries/fellowships** if not currently holding other 2017 funding, or (ii) **top up bursaries/fellowships** if holding other 2017 funding. Selection procedures take place in accordance with the *DST Ministerial Guidelines for the Equitable Distribution of NRF Bursaries and Fellowships*. Groups that are encouraged to apply are: South African citizens and permanent residents, females, and disabled persons. Postgraduate students should have at least a **minimum average of 65%** in the previous degree to be considered.
